

Senior School Uniform (Years 7 - 11)

Pupils are expected to be well turned out at all times: clothes should be clean, in good repair, and worn properly. Hair must be tidy and the length and style should be acceptable to the Assistant Head. All articles must be clearly marked with the pupil's name and Form (Y7/8) or House (Y9-11).

Girls

Girls Uniform

1. School Blazer* (navy)
2. Plain charcoal grey formal skirt (knee length) or plain charcoal grey regular fit trousers
3. Plain black belt
4. White open-necked blouse or shirt
5. Navy blue v-necked pullover (optional) but not a cardigan or a casual sweatshirt
6. Black, polished, formal style, low-heeled shoes (not casual, suede or patent leather)
NB: Shoes must not be of the type made by a sports/leisurewear manufacturer. It is advisable to own two pairs of formal shoes as the wearing of trainers as a temporary replacement is not acceptable
7. Plain dark socks/plain black tights (white socks are acceptable in summer)
8. School scarf (optional) or a plain grey, black or dark blue scarf*
9. Overcoat or raincoat of sober colour (*not leather*) (Coats and hats must be removed while in School)

Girls should limit jewellery to one pair of discreet earrings.

Physical Education and Games

1. 2 white polo shirts*
2. 2 pairs blue shorts* (required for PE)
3. 2 pairs white sports socks
4. White training shoes (non marking)
5. Plain navy/black racing-style swimming costume, navy swimming hat and towel
6. House Shirt*
7. Navy skort*(required for Games)
8. School football socks* (required for hockey)
9. Shin pads and mouthguard (required for hockey in PE and Games)
10. Black long-sleeved leotard, black footless tights (required for all those attending Gym/dance club)
11. School tracksuit and hooded top* - pupils travel to matches in these and thus are compulsory for those representing school teams

Pupils in representative teams may need other items – you will be informed about these at the appropriate time by the Head of Games.

Boys

Boys Uniform

1. School Blazer* (navy)
2. Plain charcoal grey formal trousers
3. Plain black belt
4. Plain white formal shirt (short-sleeved is acceptable in Summer, shirt must be neatly tucked in at all times)
5. Navy blue v-necked pullover (optional) but not a cardigan or a casual sweatshirt
6. School Tie*
7. Black, polished, formal shoes (not casual, suede or patent leather)
NB: Shoes must not be of the type made by a sports/leisurewear manufacturer. It is advisable to own two pairs of formal shoes as the wearing of trainers as a temporary replacement is not acceptable
8. Plain dark socks
9. School scarf (optional) or a plain grey, black or dark blue scarf*
10. Overcoat or raincoat of sober colour (*not leather*) (Coats and hats must be removed while in School)

Physical Education and Games

1. 2 PE t-shirts with Highgate crest*
2. 2 white PE shorts*
3. 2 pairs white sports socks
4. White training shoes (non marking)
5. Plain navy/black racing-style swimming trunks and towel
6. Navy/maroon football shirt*, dark blue shorts*, school football socks*, shin guards, football boots with nylon or rubber studs
7. Mouthguard (required for hockey in PE and Games)
8. House shirt*
9. Cricket whites (Defer purchase until the summer term) - white shirt, cricket sweater, white cricket trousers, white socks, cricket boots or white trainers.
10. School tracksuit and hooded top* - pupils travel to matches in these and thus are compulsory for those representing school teams

Pupils in representative teams may need other items – you will be informed about these at the appropriate time by the Head of Games.
